

**New Requirement for Rental Properties
(Excluding Condominiums)**

The Town has implemented new regulations that will require rental properties to obtain additional polycarts based on the number of bedrooms in order to accommodate their sanitation needs.

- **1-4 Bedrooms must have 1 Waste Polycart and 1 Recycling Cart**
- **5-7 Bedrooms must have 2 Waste Polycarts and 1 Recycling Cart**
- **8-9 Bedrooms must have 3 Waste Polycarts and 2 Recycling Carts**
- **10+ Bedrooms must have 4 Waste Polycarts and 2 Recycling Carts**

At the present time the Town supplies 1 Waste and 1 Recycling Cart, therefore property owners will be responsible for purchasing the additional carts as outlined above. The current cost for each additional household garbage cart and associated pickup will be \$105.36 per year. The cost for additional recycling carts will be \$56.40 per year. The Town will be monitoring for compliance of this ordinance by rental properties. These additional carts can be obtained by contacting Town Hall at 910-579-2166.

- All trash must be contained in the polycart receptacle and not be placed in bags, etc. outside of the polycart. This will be considered a littering offense as outlined in Town ordinances.
- All polycarts shall be placed within seven feet of the paved street no earlier than 6:00 PM on the evening before the trash collection. Polycarts shall be moved from the roadway by 7:00 PM on the day of service and placed adjacent to the dwelling, except in multifamily developments with centralized trash locations.
- Recycling materials should not be placed in plastic bags. This is now prohibited by the recycling companies.

Large items may be taken to the Brunswick County Convenience site located off of HWY 904, or you may take it to the main landfill in Bolivia. The information for both locations is below:
